KEY TAKEAWAYS:

- A previous OHE report in 2019 estimated that 378, 427 people in England needed palliative care a year. Our updates show that an estimated 436,022 people in England needed palliative care in 2023.
- Across the UK, an estimated 7,329 people per year or 20 people a day dying with
 no pain relief in the last 3 months of their life, even if the highest levels of hospice-level
 care are available to patients, using conservative assumptions that provide the lowest
 possible estimate.
- This is a 15% increase between 2019 to 2023 in the number of people dying in completely unrelieved pain, even at the highest standards of palliative care in England.
- Irrespective of the outcome of the upcoming decisions across the UK, investment into funding high quality end-of-life care should be a crucial component of the conversation around assisted dying in England and Wales.
